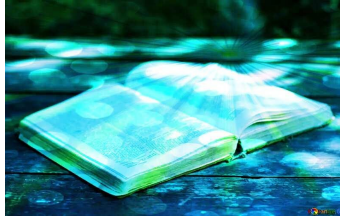


# SUMMER READING CHOICE BOARD



**Directions: Choose TWO of the choices and complete.** Choose one selection per book. Do not choose the same selection twice.

<p><b>1</b> Create a <b>fictional interview video</b> with the protagonist, antagonist, or author where you play the character/author and dress the part. Write a complete script in Google Docs and submit with the video.</p>	<p><b>2</b> Create four <b>character trading cards</b> using the digital tool of your choice. Remember to include the character's name, an image, and at least five characteristics for each character. <a href="#">Digital tool option.</a></p>	<p><b>3</b> <b>Write a diary</b> from the point of view of one of the story's main characters that they would have written before, during, or after the book's events. Remember that the character's thoughts and feelings are very important in a diary.</p>
<p><b>4</b> <a href="#">Create an interactive digital timeline</a> of events from your book. Include important dates, character introductions, conflicts and resolution, images to represent each event, and links to additional information, videos, etc. <b>Advanced:</b> add a parallel timeline that shows the classic story's information.</p>	<p><b>5</b> <b>Create a book trailer</b> that depicts an important scene from the novel. Like a movie trailer a book trailer piques the interest of a potential reader. Must be a minimum of 90 seconds and max of 180 seconds.</p>	<p><b>6</b> If this novel had a <b>soundtrack</b>, what would it be? Create a YouTube playlist with at least 10 songs that would make a great soundtrack. Explain each of your choices in a Google Doc and where they fit in the story arc.</p>
<p><b>7</b> Create a <b>comic strip</b> retelling the story in your own words. Be sure to include all of the important characters, exciting events, conflicts, and resolution. <a href="#">Storyboardthat.com</a> is a digital option for this project. <a href="#">Option two.</a></p>	<p><b>8</b> Create a video <b>book trailer</b> using the digital tool of your choice. Remember to include music to set the tone, and tell a brief story about the central conflict and characters without revealing too much! Tease the audience!</p>	<p><b>9</b> Create a new <b>book jacket</b> for the novel. Use the <a href="#">digital tool of your choice</a> or the artistic medium of your choice (draw, paint, etc.). Remember to include a summary about the author and an eye-catching cover image.</p>
